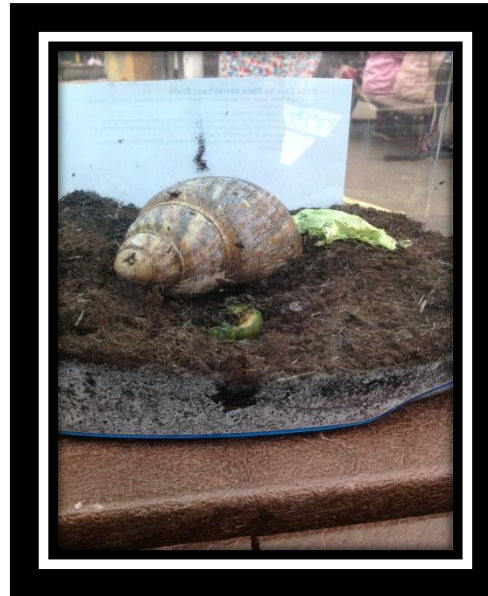

Noah " I like spaghetti"

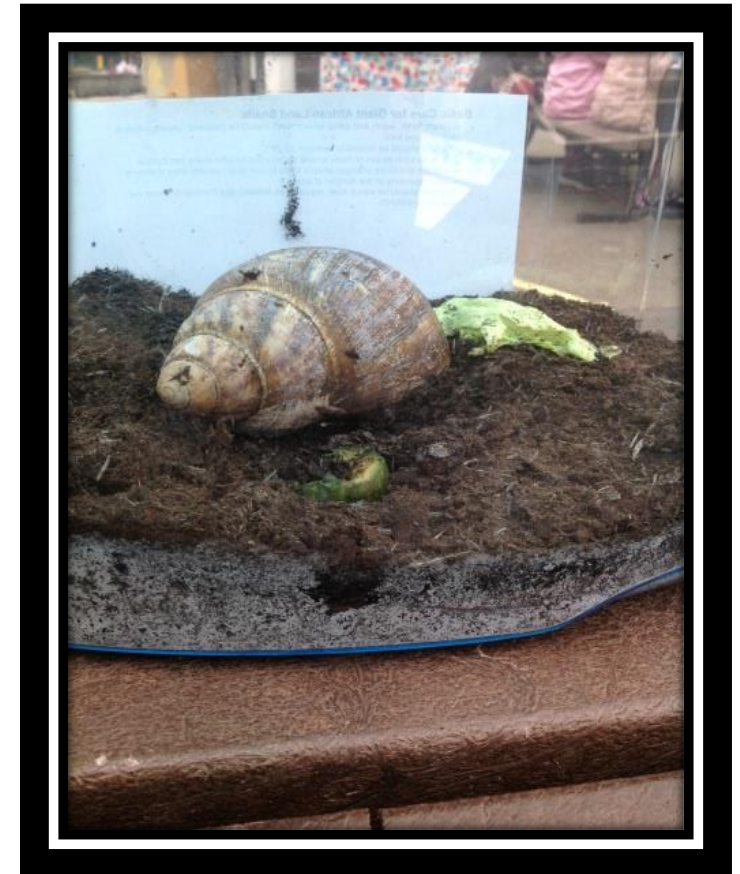
Ousman "Ice-cream"
