## Dear Parents,

Welcome to the nursery! We hope you and your child will enjoy the time you spend in the nursery. Here is some information and ways you can help.

### Start and Finish Times

Children are entitled to 15 hours per week, however there is a top up scheme available, please speak to nursery office for more information. We ask our parents to please arrive at school on time as lateness results in your child missing valuable learning time. Nursery starts at 8.45a.m. On Mondays/ Tuesdays/ Thursdays and Fridays 8.30a.m. on Wednesdays. Dinners are booked at normal start times and unless the school has been informed beforehand we cannot guarantee that a dinner can be ordered if your child is late. School dinners cost £4.20 each week for 15 hour children. Parents may collect children at 2.45p.m. Mondays/ Tuesdays/ Thursdays and Fridays. Wednesday start and finish times are 8.30a.m. to 11.30 a.m. and then 12.15p.m. to 3.15 p.m. Please be on time as arriving late can be distressing for your child.

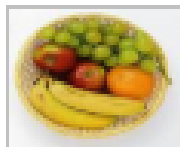


Attendance- It is important that your child attends regularly. If your child is ill or will be absent for any reason, please let us know by ringing 0121 675 2309 or 0121 359 2309 .



### Fruit

Parents are asked to bring fruit which can be shared each day at snack times.



### Clothing

Please label your child's outdoor clothing, sweat shirt and bag. Please send your child in clothes he/she can put on or take off on their own. Please provide a pair of named Wellingtons for use outside.



### Toys/Sweets/Crisps

The nursery requests that children leave toys at home as they can be easily broken or lost. Please avoid bringing sweets and cakes to school as we have fruit at snack times.



### Medicines

If your child is unwell, keep them at home until they are better. We cannot give medication (including antibiotics) unless under very special circumstances. If your child has been sick and/or has had diarrhoea, please wait 48 hours before sending your child to nursery to ensure the infection is clear. If your child requires regular medication, e.g. an inhaler for asthma, please discuss this with room staff.



### School Fund

During the year, we hold one or two fund raising events,



but in addition, we ask for a voluntary contribution of £1.00 each Monday per child. This will help cover the cost of cookery, birthday celebrations and extra activities.



### Jewellery

For safety reasons, we ask you not to send your child to school wearing earrings, rings or chains. Earrings are particularly dangerous as they can easily result in injury during physical activities.
